



# Scott County Public Health Clinics



Scott County Public Health offers several clinics for Scott County residents who are uninsured or under-insured:



**The Mobile Health Clinic** in partnership with the Shakopee Mdewakanton Sioux Community (SMCS) provides free care for short term illness, ongoing health problems, and health screenings. Clinic services are free for all residents.



**The Immunization Clinic** gives immunizations to Scott County residents age 6 weeks through adulthood. The clinic is generally open two Monday's per month from 2:00-5:00 pm. The clinic is located at the Career Force Center, 792 Canterbury Road, Suite 231. Appointments can be made by calling 952-496-8555. A \$10 donation per vaccine is appreciated, but not required.



**Nurse Walk-in Clinic** offers care for residents who need help with health issues, such as immunizations, blood pressure checks, glucose monitoring, and general health questions. The Walk-In Clinic also provides Tuberculosis skin tests (Mantoux), which are given on Tuesday and read on Thursday. There is a \$15 fee for the Mantoux testing. The Walk-In Clinic is open Tuesday and Thursday mornings 8:30-10:30 am at the Career Force Center, 792 Canterbury Road, Suite 231 in Shakopee.
